



Personal History Coach (PHC) Program

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Students who apply to participate in our PHC program are aiming to reach the highest rungs of the National History Bee, Bowl, or other social studies competitions. Those who are eligible for Hexco's PHC program will ideally have a sincere interest in history or have studied beyond the basics of the subject. Having a core foundation upon entering the PHC program is helpful, and allows those participants to expand their foundation, embarking on mastery of higher level historical concepts and themes. An assessment of your student's proficiency is 'Step 1' of the enrollment process and is described in detail below.

Author and coach, Keisha Bedwell, understands the workings of the bee and bowl and is a seasoned personal tutor who is proficient in a variety of subject areas. Under the direction of Bedwell, students can begin to form the 'bigger picture' necessary to field questions with multiple embedded facts. Hexco's PHC program also helps to determine the best methods for engaging your student, and the program assists in discovering the most effective approach for helping your student memorize important facts while synthesizing knowledge.

How it Works

Step 1 is an assessment of your student's proficiency in history. The assessment phase may take up to two weeks as tests are given and evaluated for learning style, basic skill level, and areas of expertise. Our goal is to teach students not just to work harder, but to work smarter as well, and our coach has compiled a wealth of materials to guide students in this endeavor.

Step 2 follows the assessment. Our coach will create challenging assignments tailored to each student's definitive strengths, weaknesses, and unique interests. A student's weekly assignments will entail the following:

- A quizzing session for one hour via telephone (or Skype, if preferred) to review assignments and provide explanations of complex subjects. The duration of these sessions is based on several factors, including the student's age and abilities and the difficulty of the material.
- After each session, the coach will send an email to the student and parent evaluating the student's progress in order to identify and address problem areas. All communications with the student are conducted in a positive, encouraging manner. The coach is NEVER there to grade, only to teach, motivate, and help your student stay on task.
- The coach will give each student assignments that are to be completed prior to the next coaching session. The PHC program is based on Hexco's *History Essentials* and other reliable resources, such as *Encyclopedia Britannica* and various other online websites. As the student progresses, unique research assignments tailored to a student's individual strengths, weakness, and particular interests will be administered and discussed.

Step 3 will consist of your student compiling his/her own history cards or notebook of collected information. Students will receive assignments requiring them to look up questions of a specific nature and are encouraged to create a collection of oddities that they may find along the way.

Step 4 regards parent involvement. You will be the primary person to quiz your student on the information found in their notes and flash cards on a regular basis to refresh and constantly review the voluminous bank of information expected of successful contestants. Share interesting news articles and trivia with them. Most importantly, encourage and support your student.

Distribution of Responsibilities

Responsibility of the coach

- Provide a safe and encouraging learning environment and use positive reinforcement and motivation without grading a student
- Prepare assignments to be completed by a student which cover bite-sized, manageable segments of history
- Prepare challenging questions to quiz students that are related to the segment of history currently being studied
- Continually refresh and review students over previous information
- Keep student and parents apprised of student's progress after each session
- Teach the student techniques for fielding complex questions by separating the parts of a question, breaking the question down, using process of elimination, etc.

Responsibility of the student

- Maintain a data collection on each major segment of history being studied
- Spend at least 1-2 hours daily working to complete all assignments, including researching assigned topics and searching for additional facts to add to their data collection
- Connect with the coach in a timely manner when a session is scheduled

Responsibility of the parent

- Spend time quizzing students over the current focus of study and reviewing previous material
- Correspond with coach and participate in scheduling sessions at mutually appropriate times
- Encourage the student to complete all assignments

About the Coach

Keisha Bedwell is the head coach of Hexco's PHC program and co-author of Hexco's *History Essentials*, a book endorsed by the National History Bee. With a degree in both history and psychology and years of experience coaching students of all ages, Bedwell brings a unique wealth of knowledge and insight to the coaching program. Her work in Hexco's PHC program includes application of methodology gleaned from working in university tutoring centers and from studying and observing the workings of the National History Bee and Bowl. Tuition

- Assessment plus 8 sessions of quizzing via phone/Skype of 1 hour with a personal coach plus email follow-up and assignments \$1900. Sessions may be weekly or every other week.
- Assessment plus 16 sessions via phone/Skype of 1 hour each with a personal coach plus email follow-up and assignments \$3100
- Note that the 16-session version provides a significant discount. Before the third session of an 8-session program, a student may extend to the 16-session program by paying the \$1200 difference to take advantage of the discount. After 16 sessions, each student can extend their coaching for 8 sessions at a time at \$1550 as long as the student continues to participate in the program without a significant break.
- Payment in full is required at beginning of the session by personal check, Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover, or PayPal.

Other Important Information

- We do make allowances for vacations, up to about 4 weeks at a time, and this is not considered a break in the continuation of the program.
- Most students start with 8 sessions and extend to 16 sessions before the third session. Some stop after 8 sessions, but most participants begin in the summer and remain in the program throughout the school year, and many stay in our coaching program for several years.
- PHC is conducted on a "first-come, first-serve" basis and placement in the program is dependent on our coaches' availability.
- We cannot guarantee increased placement within any bee. Ultimate placement, as you probably already know, is dependent on a variety of factors, including luck of the draw, level of study, willingness to study, student error, nervousness on stage, other competitors, etc.
- We do not offer unlimited, unscheduled, around-the-clock attention from a coach or Hexco Academic.
- Information provided to PHC students is for their use only, even when the program has been completed. All lesson plans, study lists, and guidance are provided solely for one student, and siblings may not use the lesson plans or lists.

- We ask for 24-hour advance notice in the event that a PHC student needs to reschedule or cancel an appointment. If a session is simply missed without notice, it cannot be made up without charge. Exceptions can be made in the case of a serious emergency on the student's or coach's part.

FAQs

What happens if my student misses an appointment for History instruction?

Life happens and can sometimes interfere with the best laid plans. However, a scheduled appointment, if missed, is still billed at the set fee schedule. If both parties AGREE to reschedule ahead of time, there will be no charge for the rescheduled service. A 24-hour notice is required unless a severe illness, injury, or death in the family has occurred. For instance, if your student's Science Fair is scheduled for our appointment time, you will know in advance about this and we can change our time well in advance without a problem. However, if you forget about the conflict and simply miss the scheduled appointment time, you will be charged for the appointment. If there is a serious emergency, we will reconsider. *A student who is on a weekly schedule must complete all eight sessions within 10 weeks or less; those on bi-weekly sessions must complete their sessions within 18 weeks unless interrupted by a planned family vacation, a serious illness, or a death in the family.*

What about vacations?

These can be scheduled in advance so families can have time together.

Will you come to our competitions?

Unfortunately, we will likely not be able to come to your local competitions. However, should your student make it to the National History Bee, Keisha would love to come and see your child compete.
